REQUEST FOR INFORMATION FROM FOREIGN SUPPLIERS

Hello,

Your Canadian customer is requesting your assistance to comply with a **mandatory information-gathering notice** issued under section 46 of the *Canadian Environmental Protection Act, 1999*.

The request is being made as part of the reporting requirements under Canada's Federal Plastics Registry (FPR). The FPR is a Government of Canada initiative aimed at assembling an inventory of data on plastics in the Canadian economy. The information collected through this notice will provide a better understanding of the life cycle of plastics in Canada from manufacture to end of life.

Your **Canadian customer must respond prior to the reporting deadline** to comply with the notice. Starting in 2025, the reporting deadline is every September 29th. More information on the current mandatory notice and its reporting deadlines can be found on the [Federal Plastics Registry web page](#).

As a foreign supplier, you may export to Canada resins involved in the manufacturing of plastics, or products containing such resins, and you may have information that your Canadian customer is not aware of and would not otherwise have access to. **The information you provide** will help the Government of Canada develop a complete picture of how plastics circulate in Canada.

Have you exported, to your Canadian customer, reportable plastic resins or plastic products?

Resins involved in the manufacturing of plastics, and products containing such resins, that are subject to the mandatory notice are listed in the [Notice with respect to reporting of plastic resins and certain plastic products for the Federal Plastics Registry for 2024, 2025 and 2026](#).

What type of information does your Canadian customer need?

Your Canadian customer will typically need information on the resin type, resin source, and quantity by weight of each resin in plastic resins or plastic products that you have exported to them in Canada. Resin types and resin sources are specified in Schedule 1 of the mandatory notice.
